

After the transfer is finalized, the booking will be considered as belonging to the replacement person.

Cancelled Tours

Occasionally not enough people book on a departure and the tour may have to be cancelled. Should we have to cancel any tour, you will be informed at least 14 days prior to departure and a full refund will be returned to each passenger.

Credit On File

All future travel credit and funds held from canceled tours or complimentary funds will remain valid for a period of 2 years from either the date of credit issuance or the date the cancelled tour would have commenced. After this 2-year period has passed, the credits will be null and void. Gift certificates do not have an expiration date.

Schedule Changes

Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach Tours reserves the right to make any schedule changes to improve the tour itinerary, or if circumstances beyond our control make it necessary to make changes, we reserve the right to vary itineraries. We make every effort to provide a comparable alternative and no liability shall be inferred by these efforts.

Extra Costs

Extra costs may be incurred to the customer due to interruptions or delays beyond our control due to weather or other circumstances such as roads closures. Please Note: extra lodging & food costs are NOT PAID by Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach Tours.

Identification/Passports

Please ensure the correct spelling of your name on all confirmations. Name changes on airline tickets will be at the expense of the individual.

Passports are required for all travel outside of Canada. Passports should be valid for 6 months past the date of return to Canada. Different countries require different documentation and although we will advise you of the requirements it is your responsibility to obtain the proper documentation. Travel within Canada requires a government issued photo identification.

Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach Tours will not be responsible for passengers denied access to any country or for re-entry into Canada. Please always keep your identification with you. Entry into another country may be refused even if the required information and travel documents are complete. Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach Tours will not be responsible for obtaining the required documents for any guest or for delays, damages and losses including missed portions of your vacations related to immigration issues.

Traveller's Responsibility

It is your responsibility to advise Lakeshore/Cardinal Coach Tours of any mobility issues or any special assistance that is needed at the time of booking. If you require assistance that surpasses the ability of your travelling companion, we may not be able to accept your booking. Mobility aids, the use of oxygen tanks and dietary requirements should be noted at time of booking so that we can inform you whether we can adequately accommodate your needs.

Any additional costs incurred, or any ancillary loss sustained because of cancellations or delays of tours caused by inclement weather conditions, acts of God disease or pandemic or any other event which results in one or more person's being unable to continue to complete the tour through no direct fault of the tour organizer including missed connections and late arrivals. It is agreed and understood that an increase in cost occasioned by such change shall be paid by the passenger or any decrease in costs occasion by the change shall be refunded to the passenger. When travelling you may find different living standards, practices, and conditions with respect to the provision of utilities, services, and accommodation.

Persons leaving the tour during operation will not receive a refund of unused services.

Reserved Seating

Reserved seating is for mobility issues only. For any other reason, a Dr's note needs to be provided to our office. We will make every effort to assign you the seat of your choice, but it cannot be guaranteed due to the number of requests we get. NOTE: You might not be sitting with your travelling companion if they don't require a reserved seat.

Physical and Cognitive Fitness:

Our multi-day tours are designed for individuals who are considered to be physically and cognitively fit. If you encounter difficulty moving around independently in your daily life, you may find our lighter day tours more suitable for your abilities. To join our multi-day tours, participants must be capable of walking extended distances at a reasonable pace and comfortably navigate multiple staircases. We strongly recommend that you carefully choose a tour that does not exceed your physical capabilities. This choice should align with or exceed the designated "activity level" outlined on the Lakeshore/Cardinal website and brochure for the specific tour itinerary you intend to join. Some of our tours are not suitable for individual's requiring wheelchairs or walkers. If you have concerns about your physical capabilities in relation to our tours, we encourage you to engage in a conversation with one of our reservation agents. They can assist you in selecting the tour best suited to your activity level.

Right to Refuse Service/Removal From Tour:

In the event that you choose a tour that exceeds your physical or cognitive capabilities, and you are unable to keep up or are consistently holding up the group, Lakeshore/Cardinal reserves the right to remove you from the tour, and any associated costs will be your responsibility. No refund for unused services will be provided. Additionally, we hold the authority to decline any individual as a tour member at our sole discretion, at any time and for any reason if, in our judgment or in the judgment of a third-party service provider on the tour, a guest's condition may impact the health, safety, or overall experience of other travelers. Our utmost concern is your safety and wellbeing. If continuing the tour poses a risk to your health or comfort, we may need to make arrangements for you to exit the tour while ensuring your safe return to your point of origin.

Assistance Requirement:

If you are unable to navigate independently, it is imperative that you have a companion accompanying you to provide assistance. The tour director's availability to offer personal assistance is limited as their primary focus is to support the entire group. Lakeshore/Cardinal does not provide personal equipment (e.g., wheelchairs, hearing aids, prescription eyeglasses) nor do we offer personal care services (such as assistance eating, using the restroom, or dressing themselves). Travellers in need of personal care services (including dining, restroom needs, or getting dressed) are required to bring a companion to assist and should be aware that fellow travellers, travel directors, and Lakeshore/Cardinal staff are not available to provide such aid.

Luggage Handling:

All tour participants are expected to manage their own luggage throughout the journey when luggage handling is not included. Please pack according to your limitations.

Challenges and Limitations:

Please be aware that certain tours may involve considerable walking and could pose challenges to travellers with disabilities or mobility constraints. Many historic sites are accessible solely on foot and may feature stairs or hilly terrain.

Activity Levels

Level One – Light I enjoy exploring with plenty of options to sit and enjoy the surroundings.

• I have no problem walking unassisted or with a mobility device, at a relaxed pace for up to 400 meters with short breaks to catch my breath.

• I can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a motor coach without assistance, stand for minimum 10 minutes, and get on/off an escalator without assistance.

• Travel companions are suggested for those passengers with mobility constraints and are required if you cannot manage any of the above on your own.

• Please note that foldable wheelchairs or walkers cannot exceed 50 lbs.

Level Two – Moderate Travel for me is a balance between actively exploring new things and relaxing.

- I have no problem walking unassisted at a moderate pace for 1-2km with some short breaks.
- I can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a motor coach without assistance, manage a variety of terrain and moderate hills with rest stops. I can stand for minimum 15 minutes.
- Navigating large venues, malls, airports, and hotels is doable with a little guidance.
- This level is not suitable for travellers who require mobility assistance devices (i.e.) walkers, wheelchairs.

Level Three – Active I am an active traveller. I love exploring, walking, and standing for longer periods of time.

• I have no problem walking unassisted at an active pace for up to 3-5 km with rest stops scattered throughout. • I can climb at least 3-4 flights of stairs and manage navigating uneven terrain, cobblestone, and hills at a medium pace with rests.

- Navigating large venues, airports, and hotels is not a problem.
- This level is not a suitable for travellers who require mobility assistance devices of any type.

Level Four – Very Active I live a very active life. My FitBit may often measure upwards of 10,000 steps in a day!

- I have no problem walking unassisted at an active pace for 5+ km a day with short breaks.
- I can climb multiple flights of stairs throughout the day, navigate uneven terrain, and steeper hills with no issue.
- I can stand for longer periods and manage a variety of altitudes and temperatures.
- Navigating large venues, airports, and hotels is not a problem.
- This level is not suitable for travellers who require mobility assistance devices of any type.
